Medical / Non-medical external appointments & visits

As you know, Jamia is running on charitable donations alongside parental contributions in a category-based system. The parental contribution (whatever amount that is) is a contribution towards costs of education, meals and supervision in the residential. The contribution does not cover the full cost per student as you will know from the first day of induction.

The arrangement and costs of healthcare visits (GP, Hospital, Dental Care) or any other external visits such as trips and excursions are the sole responsibility of the parents and are not included in the parental contributions.

In the case of an emergency – parents are contacted so that they can try their best to come as soon as possible to accompany their child for the emergency. If this is not possible, the management approaches staff (all our staff have DBS checks in places) to give up their own time to accompany any child to appointments/emergencies. We then communicate with the parents – who usually allow to proceed with costs

mentioned. Most parents are very grateful that we can help them in this regard as sometimes they have no way of making it on that day due to commitments etc.

Alhamdu lillah, we appreciate that staff give up their personal time, rest/sleep and risk infection/Covid in an hospital environment – despite a minority of parents not appreciating this as they should. Parents should remind their children that an emergency is an emergency and money is not more important than health. Many a time parents have paid very late –but staff have never raised any issue, because, for them, student well-being is more important. We will also provide invoices to parents who request so to avoid any confusion of hours and costs between students/parents.
