Dear parents/guardians,

*This is a broadcast email message.*

We hope you are all in the best of health and Iman and keeping safe in the current situation. We miss all our students and parents and pray that we will be able to meet again soon In Shaa Allah (SWT).

We are writing to update you about the 3<sup>rd</sup> Instalment and what decision has been made in regards to that. We are aware that many parents make great sacrifices for their daughters to study and that it is already financially difficult for many parents to keep up to date in general. We understand it is even more difficult in times like these. Therefore, we have taken time and not requested any payments as of yet from any parents including any outstanding payments from the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> Parental Instalments.

The first step we took to ease the financial pressure from everyone including the Jamia was to request staff to agree to the Government furlough scheme and Alhamdu Lillah, most of the staff has agreed to that in order to support the Jamia and parents at this difficult time. Unfortunately, this has meant that staff is no longer instructed to carry out work due to the government conditions of the scheme. We had no option but to apply for the scheme as we know that most parents will not be able to pay the full amount and this would have jeopardized the survival of Jamia.

However, we now need urgent support from the parents to meet the standing costs of utilities contracts and maintenance costs so that the Jamia is not adversely affected due to the current situation. **Please update any outstanding payments as soon as possible.**

## **How much do I pay for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Instalment?**

After consulting with other institutes similar to ours we have come to the conclusion to **request 50% of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Parental Contribution Instalment**. If students do not return until the end of this Academic year then that will be the final payment for this year. However, if students return then we will adjust the amount to factor that in on a pro-rata basis.

If any parent would like to honour their financial contribution in full then that would be welcome as we are sure you understand that the parental contribution is not enough and we always rely of donations to continue.

## **How can I pay?**

The best and safest way is by **bank transfer**. Please include your daughter's name and class as reference when you transfer. You can email us or Whatsapp us the receipt of the online transfer to ensure we have logged your payment to make a receipt for you.
